As Readers & Writers we will...

In reading and writing we will be focusing on the narrative 'The True Story Of The 3 Little Pigs'. Using this text, we will be innovating our own stories. We will use text mapping to learn the story.

Later in the term, we will be writing a chronological report about the Great Fire of London.

As Mathematicians we will be starting our topic on addition and subtraction:

- Learning how add and subtract in a column.
- Exchanging and borrowing.
- Place value

As Musicians we will...


Focusing on the unit 'HO HO HO' in preparation for our festive season. We will also be practising for our Christmas performance.
