As Mathematicians......

We will be learning about multiplication and division. We will look at how numbers change when they are multiplied and divided. We will be able to identify factors, common factors and prime numbers. We will look at measurement and area. We will be able to find the area foe a rectangle.

In speech, language and communication...

We will be exploring and developing our expressive language and turn taking skills through topic-based activities and games.

As Athletes we will...

Be developing our games skills and will focus on team games and including games that require choices and decisions.

As Scientists we will...

We will be looking at the rainforests of the world, the indigenous people that live there and the devastating effects that deforestation can have on our rainforests. We will look at different biomes and the climates of these, habitats and how we can classify living things.

Big Question(s):

Why is the rainforest important?

As Writers and readers we will...

Be looking at key features of a leaflet and how to create our own. We will also look at examples of persuasive letter texts and their key features in order to write our own persuasive letters about deforestation. We will explore fiction and non-fictional texts directly linked to the Big question and be using ICT to help support our learning. We will use retrieval skills to answer questions after reading texts.

As Musicians we can/we will...

Be following the Charanga SEND curriculum 'Anyone can play' and we will be exploring instruments, songs and learning the lyrics to various songs to enable the children to preform songs.

As Computer technicians we will...

Be learning about e-safety and looking at different computing systems and networks. We will discover what a network is and how websites work. We will use ICT to support our research and learning related to the topic.

In Life skills.....

We will be learning about economics and looking at recipes and how to write and buy our own ingredients to make simple food recipes.

Sticky words for this half term:

In Religious Education...

We will follow the Leicester agreed syllabus.

And be thinking about what we can learn from different religions about different religious beliefs.

In PSHE...
